In its broadest sense salvation includes regeneration, justification, sanctification, and glorification. There is no salvation apart from personal faith in Jesus Christ as Lord.*

*“Such is the provision which God hath made through Christ in the Covenant of Grace, for the preservation of Believers until Salvation, that although there is no sin so small, but it deserves damnation; yet there is no sin so great, that it shall bring damnation on them that repent; which makes the constant preaching of Repentance necessary.”*

- Regeneration- new birth
- Justification- acquittal of judgment and imputation of righteousness
- Sanctification- the process of becoming like Jesus Christ
- Glorification- culmination of salvation and receiving the likeness of Christ
